

## Pewsey Vale School - Year 7 Catch-Up Premium Spending 2015-2016

The Year 7 Catch Up Premium is provided to help those pupils who obtained level 3 or below in KS2 English and Maths. This academic year there are seven such pupils, all of whom are also on the SEND register. The additional funding of £500 per child equates to a total of £3500 for this academic year.

The funding is being used in the following ways to help these students catch up:

- Accelerated Reader programme (all)
- Library lunchtime craft club (NW, MP, LB)
- 1-1 Teaching Assistant support (LB)
- Corrective reading programme (LB)
- 1-1 Maths tuition (LB)
- Spelling support (all)
- SPAG lessons via Accelerated Reader (all)
- Small group Maths tuition during withdrawal from lessons (JJ, LB, SM, MP)
- Boys Group – literacy support 3x per week (all boys)
- ELSA Support (MP, MW, LB)
