- 1 How to complete your application:** There's still time to get your completed application into S6C! It's really simple, just pop on to our website <https://www.salisbury6c.ac.uk/> and click APPLY NOW. The application deadline has passed - however we can still accept your application; but it will be considered as a late application. If you need any help or have any questions please email admissions@salisbury6c.ac.uk and we will get back to you.
- 2 Interview:** Once we have your completed application and reference from your current school, the next step is to invite you to an interview. These are now being held by telephone. We will contact you with a time for your telephone interview. The interview is an opportunity for you discuss your course choices and future ambitions and ask any questions you may have about the college.
- 3 Offer of a place:** Following a successful interview you will be offered a place to study at S6C. An offer email is sent to you to confirm your conditional offer. You will need to log in to your account on the application system once you have received this to accept your offer.
- 4 Freshers Day:** We are intending to go virtual this year! Our planned Freshers Day for June looks uncertain now; but we are busy planning a virtual event so that all the information you need before starting at S6C and what to expect is available to you!
- 5 What you can do:** We are here to support you through this transition from school to college to ensure it is as smooth as possible. The teaching staff at S6C are planning to introduce resources for you to use to prepare for your level 3 studies! Although you may not be sitting your exams this summer, it's really important to prepare yourself for your next step in education. Keep checking your emails - more details to follow!
- 6 Enrolment:** Our enrolment days are planned for late August, after you have collected your GCSE results. We will invite you in to S6C, with your GCSE certificates in hand and enrol you onto your programme of study. This is another opportunity to discuss with the staff your subject choices. At present we still plan to do this, but your safety is our priority and we will follow government guidelines at the time.
