EVENTS THIS WEEK

- On Monday morning our Year 11 students sat their English Literature Paper 1 exam, this marked the start of a busy week of exams for them.
- On Tuesday afternoon Year 11 students sat their first Biology exam.
- Wednesday and Thursday this week saw the Year 9 students have their options meetings to discuss what subjects they would look to be taking forward to KS4.
- On Wednesday morning Year 11 students sat their first Geography exam.
- Thursday saw a full day of exams for Year 11, with Maths paper 1 in the morning and German writing in the afternoon.
- On Friday morning Year 11 students sat their first History exam.
- After school on Friday the group of Year 11 students undertaking their Bronze DofE award had a training session in readiness for their expedition at the end of June. They learned how to put up and strike the tent, use the camping stove, pack a full rucksack, set a map and compass, and complete a route card.

EVENTS COMING UP

- Applications are now open for Year 10 students to put their names forward for the positions of Head Girl, Head Boy, Deputy Head Girl and Deputy Head Boy. The applications need to be in by the end of term and interviews will be held early next term.
- We break up on Friday 23rd May for a week for May half term, students and staff will be back in school on Monday 2nd June.
- On Wednesday 11th June our SEN department is taking a group of students to Longleat Safari Park for the day.
- Our Year 7 Parent's Evening will take place on Thursday 12th June. This will be held in school between 4pm and 7pm and booking details will be sent out closer to the date.
- Tuesday 17th June we have the school immunisation team in for Year 9 Td/IPV and Meningitis vaccine which helps protect against tetanus, diphtheria, polio and meningitis. The Td/IPV vaccine is a booster vaccine. You need a total of 5 doses of tetanus, diphtheria and polio vaccines to build up and keep your immunity. You should have had the first 3 doses as a baby, dose 4 when you were between 3 and 5 years old (pre-school booster) and dose 5 is due in Year 9 (aged 13/14). A consent form from HCRG has been sent to parents, and reminder will be sent out in due course.
- On Friday 20th June our Year 11 DofE students will head off on their Bronze expedition, this is the first expedition we have run through the school and we are very excited to hear how they get on.
- Thursday 26th June will be our Year 11 Prom, once being held again at the beautiful Chalk Barn in Rushall.
