EVENTS THIS WEEK

- On Monday we launched our amended Behaviour Policy. These amendments reflect those adopted across the 3 other Acorn Education secondary schools and fall in line with the latest Department for Education (DfE) guidance (September 2024). Alongside the amendments to our behaviour policy, we have amended our approach to mobile phones and devices (Inc. ear phones and smart watches). We believe in empowering students to sensibly use their mobile devices during non-curricular times, before school, breaktime, lunchtime and after school. Other than at these times students should ensure that mobile devices are turned off and out of site.
