### Letter to Parents and Stakeholders regarding Multi-Academy Trust status

Dear Stakeholders,

Over the course of the year, the Governing Body along with leaders of Pewsey Vale School have been investigating options with regard to joining a Multi-Academy Trust to continue to grow our school. Three academy trusts were invited to present to the Governing Body, and we are pleased to announce that Acorn Education Trust were the preferred MAT (Multi-Academy Trust) of choice.

Acorn Education Trust have vast experience across all phases of schools and pride themselves on providing education locally to ensure the best quality for all students. Currently, Acorn have a total of 17 primary and nursery schools and 3 secondary schools. Pewsey Vale will be the fourth secondary school to join Acorn Education Trust with others potentially joining early next year. The Governing Body felt that Acorn's core values aligned well with ours, and as a small school would provide us with more opportunities for students and staff to develop.

I am therefore pleased to inform you that as from 1st December 2024, Pewsey Vale School will become part of Acorn Education Trust. This collaboration has also been given the go ahead by the Schools Regional Director's office and the Department for Education.

In terms of the day to day running of the school, very little will change. We will continue to be Pewsey Vale School, keeping our values and identity. However, being part of the Trust will enable us to work collaboratively with the other

schools to add capacity and resources where required. We are all very excited to be part of this new adventure, and I hope you are too. We have been working collaboratively with the Trust over the past few terms and already seeing some benefits. We will keep you informed of our situation
