I will be able to address all staff by their first names.

I do not need to wear a uniform unless my course states otherwise:

- Hairdressing and beauty students will need to wear a uniform.
- Personal Protective Equipment such as steel toe capped boots and hi-vis jackets are required for our construction courses.

I will still be informed about my progress through parent's evenings.
