### I'VE ALREADY ACCEPTED MY NEW COLLEGE OFFER; WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

If you already hold an offer from us, you will be invited in to one of our Enrolment Days – these are scheduled for Thursday August 25th, Friday August 26th and Tuesday August 30th. You will receive your invitation letter by post around 10th August, so please look out for it then. This will have a date and time for you to come into College, provide your GCSE results, discuss your choices and finalise your enrolment. You will then receive information on your induction session and timetable collection. If you have moved house since you made your original application, then you MUST tell us, otherwise you will not receive Enrolment information – email <a href="mailto:enrolment@newcollege.ac.uk">enrolment@newcollege.ac.uk</a>. If you have applied recently to us and not had your interview, you will be contacted very shortly to arrange an interview by our Liaison Team.

# IT'S GCSE RESULTS DAY AND I NEED URGENT ADVICE ON MY COLLEGE APPLICATION – WHAT DO I DO?

Our Main Enrolment period starts on Results Day and new Year 11s will mainly have appointments on Thursday and Friday. Simply keep your Enrolment appointment as normal and we will provide advice when you come in.

## I HAVEN'T GOT THE GCSE GRADES I NEED FOR MY COURSE WITH YOU: WHAT DO I DO?

We know you will inevitably be disappointed but try not to worry. We offer courses at all levels so there will be a course here for you and we can guarantee a place for you. Our GCSEs/Level 1 and 2 vocational courses can be completed in one year and we can help you progress to the course you want to do. If you have not achieved grade 4 in English Language or Maths, you will need to study this as part of your study here. Simply keep your Enrolment appointment as normal – you will receive advice and guidance when you come into College on what is available.

#### I WANT TO CHANGE MY COURSE; HOW CAN I DO THAT?

This is perfectly normal. We would advise that you keep your Enrolment appointment anyway and we can advise you when you come into College.

## I CAN'T MAKE THE ENROLMENT DATES AS I'M AWAY; WHAT DO I DO?

Once you receive your invitation letter, please email us and let us know you can't attend but still intend to come to New College in September. Please include the date you are available from so we can reschedule your appointment. We will need you to come in and formally enrol as soon as you are able to; but will be able to include you in our timetabling system.
