- Applications for the **Cotswold Airport Aviation Scholarship** this year. This scholarship, which is fully funded by the airport, has been running for over 10 years and is based here at Cotswold Airport on the Gloucestershire/Wiltshire boundary. It is aimed at 15 to 18 year olds and will be taking place from Monday 5th August to Saturday 10th August 2024.
