EVENTS THIS WEEK

- On **Wednesday** we held our **transition event** for the new year 7 students joining us in September. Students joined us in school during the day to have their first taste of secondary school life.
- We held a **Year 5 Taster Day** on **Friday**. Students took part in fun activities, enjoyed a picnic lunch and much more. A great opportunity for students to experience secondary school life.

EVENTS COMING UP

- Sports Day** will be held on **Thursday 10th July**, students will participate in a variety of activities all day and will be able to score points for their Houses.
- Bags 2 School** will be making a collection from school on **Monday 14th July**. Bags will be sent home with students prior to this for you to fill with any unwanted items of clothing. It is a fantastic way for the PTFA to raise funds for the school.
- On **Tuesday 15th July** our **Year 10** students are visiting the **Ramsbury Estate**. This trip is a fantastic opportunity to expand cultural capital and careers experiences for our students. During the day they will be given a tour of the farm and wider estate. In the afternoon they will take part in an enterprise workshop. The day is going to be very varied and allow students to experience learning outside of the classroom/school environment. The cost of this trip is £8 per student, inclusive of the coach travel and all workshops. For families who are in receipt of free school meals, we will use the pupil premium to cover half of this cost on your behalf. Payment can be made either online via Parentpay, or by cash or card to the school office.
- On **Wednesday 16th July** our Year 7 students will be undertaking a **first aid course** run by the Wiltshire Air Ambulance service. The cost of this course is £2.50 per student, payment can be made via ParentPay or into the school office and should be made by Friday 11th July.
- We will break up for the **summer holiday** on **Tuesday 22nd July** and we will **finish at 12.30pm**.

School will re-open for the **Year 7 only** on **Thursday September 3rd**, all other year groups will start back on **Thursday 4th September**.
